## **Job Description:**

### **June 2-5:**

- plan activities for Training Week
- plan staff activity nights and weekend activities for the summer
- plan activities for July mini-retreat

### **Training Week:**

- assembling camper booklets
- gathering materials and assembling Counselor Packets
- planning & prepping cabin devo materials
- lead icebreakers and team-building exercises

### **Summer Camps:**

- Weekends:
  - o planning of Saturday activity for staff (when there is no camp on Saturday)
    - this could include a hike, bowling, movie, etc (please coordinate with Senior Staff and Head Cook)
    - help with transportation for event (drive van)
  - o assist with transportation (drive van) to Elko for church & shopping Sunday
  - o purchase and organization of cabin devotion materials for coming week
- Mondays:
  - o overseeing assembly of Counselor Packets:
    - camper lists
    - packet labels
    - schedules
    - T-shirt order forms
    - memory verse forms
    - decision cards
    - camper surveys
    - counselor handbooks
  - o leading Counselor Training and prayer time
- all week
  - o attend 7:00am Counselor Meetings, pray with counselors of your gender
  - o attend after-breakfast staff meeting, give feedback & support to staff
  - o assist with dishwashing according to scheduled rotation
  - o interact with staff, counselors, and campers at all possible opportunities

- assist counselors with difficult campers (possibly by sitting with them during chapel or meals)
- afternoons:
  - schedule one-on-one time with staff members during their time off
  - attend freetime activities with cabin groups, interact with campers and counselors
- evenings:
  - attend Cabin Discussion time with different cabin groups
  - patrol Cabin area of your gender after Lights Out
- once per week
  - plan special evening activity with staff members of your gender
- July “mini retreat”
  - plan and lead staff activities
